

Great Lakes Council - Beach access for dogs guidelines

OFF THE LEASH

From Sanderling Avenue car park and North along the beach up to the National Park Boundary Only - 24 hour access.

The National Park starts 4.3 km north of Tuloa Ave, Hawks Nest.



ON THE LEASH

From the very southern end of Bennett Beach to Yaccabba and around to the Boulders and Jimmys Beach, Hawks Nest (where not signposted otherwise)



Owners who fail to keep their dogs leashed in public places (leash free areas excepted) or take their dogs into prohibited places may be issued with an on the spot fine \$165.00

No access from the southern end of Bennetts Beach to the Hawks Nest Golf Club car park. This means you can not walk past the surf life saving club with your dog on a lead.

We also have native dingos in the area and all holiday guests must exercise extreme caution when taking their dog off a leash.

Domestic animals are not permitted to enter National Parks

All dogs must be micro chipped and registered.

PICKING UP AFTER YOUR PET

Dog waste must also be picked up in public areas. Failure to pick up after your pet can also attract a fine of \$275.00.
